# Important: Please read carefully before the audition and only attend if you are happy with the following notes.

This year promises to be even more exciting as we take the audience on a magical journey meeting magical creatures and Princesses, heroes and villains, and a really enormous giant! This classic story will be brought to life in a brand new enthralling pantomime. There will be lots of singing, dancing and also acting, as the kids are going to appear as a wide variety of characters.

There will be two teams of children, each cast performing, on alternate days from 30<sup>th</sup> December to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Though it is not possible at this time to give a definite rehearsal schedule all successful candidates must be available for production week and all performances. Detailed rehearsal and performance dates for each cast will be announced once the casting process has been completed.

We will be asking for parents and guardians of all children taking part in the pantomime to assist us backstage during rehearsals and performances. Please keep an eye out for the roster on our Facebook group "Jack and the Beanstalk 2022". Please consider this commitment before auditioning.

# Rehearsal Commitment

Rehearsals will commence with a script read through Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October at The Weld Theatre. Though it is not possible at this time to give a definite rehearsal schedule, all successful candidates must be available for production week and all performances. Detailed rehearsal and performance dates for each cast will be announced once the casting process has been completed. We kindly ask that you look at the production dates and ensure you will be able to commit fully to the show before auditioning. When completing your audition application please note any dates you will be unavailable. Please bring drinks and snacks to your rehearsals. No food is to be consumed within the theatre auditorium.

#### Auditions

Children do not need to prepare an audition piece as the sessions will be run in a workshop style with everyone having the chance to demonstrate his or her talents.

Junior auditions will be held on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> October 4-6pm, auditions will be in 15 minute timeslots with 5-6 children. Children will be auditioning for Directors Ingrid Hanemaaijer and Gizelle Salame

Unfortunately, parents will not be able to remain in the Acting Up studio for the audition. However, please note that children aged 13 and under remain the responsibility of the parents/guardians at all times and, therefore, it is recommended that parents/guardians remain in the ArtGeo Courtyard throughout the audition.
